

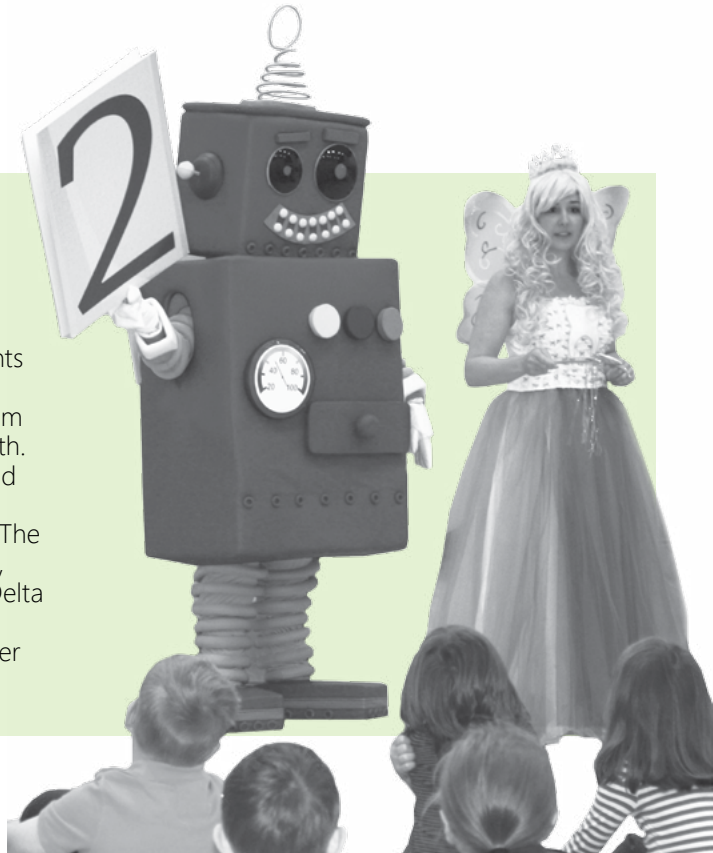
## 2015 INTERPROFESSIONAL CHILDREN'S ORAL HEALTH SUMMIT

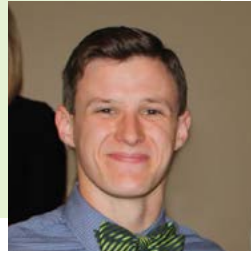

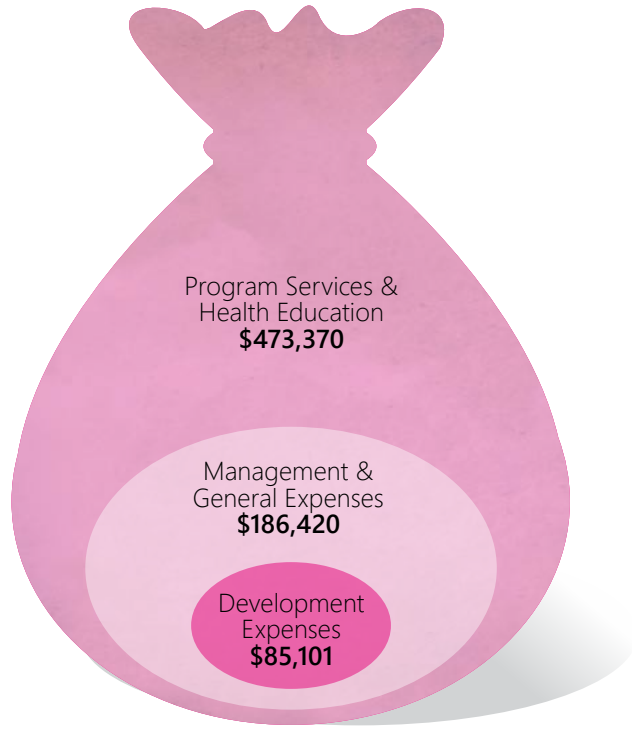
